
Linen Instruction


You will need to bring a plastic bag or two with you each week. Or something to pick up the towels to transport home, because they will be damp.

After Mass each week:

- 1. Go behind the altar and pick up any linens hanging on the rail or laying out on the credence table.
- 2. Go to Fr Tom's sacristy by the sacrarium (the sink with no faucet⁽¹⁾) and get the linens that are in the plastic bin. These linens will be soaking in a small amount of water. The remaining water may be poured down that drain. You may wring the linens out in there as well.
- 3. Wash linens in a separate load of laundry and use bleach as needed. Some items may have lipstick or stain marks that need special attention. (Typically, letting the linens soak for a number of hours will take almost all of the stains from the precious blood).
- 4. Add fabric softener to avoid static cling.
- 5. EACH piece must be ironed and folded as listed:
 - a. **Purificators**-used to clean up the Precious Blood from the chalices.



b. Corporals-used on the Altar during Consecration. (Cross is face up in diagram)



- 6. Other linens that might be included will be fingertip towels that Fr Tom uses before the consecration or a large bath towel that he might have used during a Baptism. These can be folded neatly any way you wish.
- 7. Return all items before the next Saturday Mass
 - a. **Purificators, Corporals and fingertip towels**-return to the built-in shelf behind the Altar.
 - b. **Bath size towels**-return to the closet in the Server Sacristy. If you open the closet, there should be a plastic bin on the floor that holds all the larger towels.

^{**}If you are ever in a hurry during the week and need to drop the clean linens off to the parish office, Kelli can put them away for you. This is not a problem at all.
